## What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following information to **provide services and goods, including delivery**:

We also collect or use the following special category information to **provide services and goods, including delivery.** This information is subject to additional protection due to its sensitive nature:

• Biometric information (where used to identify someone)



We collect or use the following information for **the operation of customer accounts and guarantees**:

- Names and contact details
- Addresses
- Payment details (including card or bank information for transfers and direct debits)
- Purchase history
- Account information, including registration details
- Marketing preferences

We also collect or use the following special category information for **the operation of customer accounts and guarantees.** This information is subject to additional protection due to its sensitive nature:

• Biometric information (where used to identify someone)

We collect or use the following personal information for **dealing with queries, complaints or claims**:

- Names and contact details
- Account information
- Purchase or service history
- Customer or client accounts and records

# Lawful bases and data protection rights

Under UK data protection law, we must have a "lawful basis" for collecting and using your personal information. There is a list of possible <u>lawful</u> <u>bases</u> in the UK GDPR. You can find out more about lawful bases on the ICO's website.

Which lawful basis we rely on may affect your data protection rights which are set out in brief below. You can find out more about your data protection rights and the exemptions which may apply on the ICO's website:

- Your right of access You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. You can request other information such as details about where we get personal information from and who we share personal information with. There are some exemptions which means you may not receive all the information you ask for. You can read more about this right here.
- Your right to rectification You have the right to ask us to correct or delete personal information you think is inaccurate or incomplete. You can read more about this right here.
- **Your right to erasure** You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information. <u>You can read more about this right here</u>.

# Where we get personal information from

We get information from our own system (WHMCS), users input their data such as Name, Address, Email, Phone Number and we can see it this is used for when payments are being processed by our system (for this we use stripe). All of your website files and anything you do on any of our hosting packages are stored on the DirectAdmin server, this is owned by Namecrane LLC.

### Website Live Chat

Upon accepting our privacy policy in the live chat window you will now be on our monitoring list, this means that we can see your IP address. Then starting a live chat with us, you will be asked for your name, email address and which department you require, we can see that information and then you will be connected to an agent - by using our live chat you agree to this.



# How long we keep information

Your personal data is stored for as long as your account is active, if you have no active service and do not login for 2 weeks your account will be moved to inactive accounts however, your information is still stored. We have no retention schedules for deleting data. Under data protection laws, all customers have the right to access all data held about them, request for it to be removed, modify the set data.
