Lawful bases and data protection rights

Where we get personal information from

We get information from our own system (WHMCS), users input their data such as Name, Address, Email, Phone Number and we can see it this is used for when payments are being processed by our system (for this we use stripe). All your website files and anything you do on any of our hosting packages are stored on the DirectAdmin server, this is owned by PhoenixDev LLC. If you are to purchase a Discord Bot Hosting package from us, this is a server which we manage but rent from Contabo GmbH. Our professional email hosting is a server owned by Namecrane LLC.

How long we keep information

Your personal data is stored in our system until we manually delete it upon request, if you do not use your client account it will be moved to the inactive status however, your information is still stored and will only be deleted upon your request.
